Client Support Worker

SASHA Supportive Living has openings for **Client Support Workers** to support mental health clients in a 24 hour residential program. SASHA is currently hiring for all positions including full-time, part-time and casual/relief. All shifts are available with the expectation that the applicant be able to work days, evenings and nights

Duties include:

- Client support with daily living skills, community integration, recreation, residential living, and individual goal achievement
- Assess and assist client in managing symptoms through redirection, medication management, education, communication through verbal and written reporting
- Monitor medication compliance, provide reminders, assess and document compliance, report concerns to Case Managers
- Assess and support client's personal care routine, nutrition and meal preparation, laundry and basic household maintenance

Wages start at \$15.25 per hour depending on education and experience. Part-time work ideal for university/college students.

Education:

- Some college/university education in related field,
- Experience in mental health/group homes an asset,
- Additional training is available upon commencement.

Valid driver's license and criminal record/vulnerable sector check required prior to start date.
