2023 VOLUNTEER CELEBRATION AWARDS SCHOLARSHIP

Donor: Rotary Club of Lethbridge Sunrise

Value: \$1,000 Number: One

Eligibility-candidate pool:

- Must attend a designated educational institution and owe tuition prior to July 15 of the current academic year.
- Must be a recipient of the Volunteer Celebration Award.

Criteria-ranking the pool:

 Recipients should clearly demonstrate "Service Above Self" - the principal motto of Rotary, best conveying the philosophy of unselfish volunteer service.

Payable:

Payment upon confirmation of full-time enrolment in a post-secondary study (including trades apprenticeship) programs or to support students already in an undergraduate program.

A letter will be provided to the student informing the post-secondary institution that Lethbridge Sunrise has awarded this student a scholarship of \$1,000, and Lethbridge Sunrise will forward the institution the award, receipts to be forwarded to Lethbridge Sunrise.

Application:

Not required.

Recipient Selection:

Volunteer Celebration Awards administrators will be responsible for identifying the most deserving candidates if a tie-breaking decision is required.
